Every April, Steps to HOPE becomes a voice for victims of sexual assault and violence and "joins the conversation" through a nationwide campaign called The Clothesline Project. The purpose is to be a silent but visible witness to sexual abuse and violence. The display honors a survivor's strength to continue and provides another avenue courageously break the silence surrounding their experience. Clients, staff, volunteers, and survivors decorate t-shirts bearing facts of sexual assault, things they were told during their experience, call to action for EVERYONE, and courageous words of affirmation for survivors.

The Clothesline Project appears at Stearns Park in Columbus, Steps to HOPE Thrift Barn in Landrum, McCreery Park in Saluda, and downtown Tryon.

Over half of women have experienced contact sexual violence in their lifetime.



Every 68 seconds, someone in the U.S. is sexually assaulted.



Almost 1 in 3 men have experienced contact sexual violence in their lifetime.



Sexual assault is intentional sexual contact by use of force, physical threat or abuse of authority, or when the victim does not or cannot consent.

- Go to a safe place
- Preserve evidence
- Seek medical care ASAP
- Call 911 if you are in physical danger
